To insert the following proposition after Proposition 7:-

“8. To amend Rule 28(3)(b) of the Rules of Procedure by inserting the following words at the end:-

“, speaking only on behalf the committee of which they are President or Vice-President”.

**Rule 4(1) Information**

- a) The propositions contribute to the States' objectives and policy plans by ensuring that the Rules of Procedure support fair and relevant debate.
- b) No consultation has taken place with other committees.
- c) The proposition has been submitted to His Majesty's Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) There are no financial implications to the States of Guernsey in carrying the proposal into effect.

**Explanatory Note**

This Amendment would, where a Requête is being debated by the Assembly, require speeches to be given by relevant committee Presidents or Vice-Presidents before a representative of the requérants replies to the debate, to be used solely to relay the views of the committee of which they are President,
