### **AMENDMENT**

Proposed by: Deputy J Gollop Seconded by: Deputy A Matthews

To delete proposition 1 and substitute the following:

- "To approve the increase of the number of Members of the States Assembly by 7, up to 45 Guernsey Deputies in total, such increase to be implemented in time for the General Election to be held on the 18<sup>th</sup> June 2025."
- 2. To Insert into Proposition 2 after "rule changes" the following ", proportional salary reduction relative to the increase in the number of Members.."

# Rule 4(1) Information

- a) The propositions contribute to the States objectives and policy plans by increasing talent, choice opportunity and good deliberations and debate.
- b) In preparing the proposition consultation has taken place with the Policy and resources Committee and the States' Assembly & Constitution Committee
- c) The proposition has been submitted to His Majesty's Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) There are no financial implications to the States of Guernsey in carrying the proposal into effect.

## **Explanatory Note**

The intention of this amendment is to return the States to the number of Deputies elected between 2000 and 2016 at no affordable cost, the total amount of money paid to each member being proportionally reduced from £43,036 to £36,341.51 approximately if approved.
