Explanatory note

The Scrutiny Management Committee believes it is essential that the resources allocated to the Committee are clearly and transparently identified. The omission of this information in the Budget Report means that the level of resources available to Scrutiny in 2026 is not visible either to Members of the States or to the public.

Such a lack of transparency is incompatible with modern standards of open government and falls short of the expectations rightly placed on a body tasked with ensuring accountability and good governance.

The Committee is also firmly of the view that the independence of Scrutiny must not only exist but be seen to exist. Pooling Scrutiny's budget with that of another Committee even with assurances of operational autonomy risks creating the perception that independence is being eroded.

To maintain public confidence and trust in the scrutiny process, it is vital that Scrutiny's resources are distinct, visible, and under the direct control of the Committee itself.
