AMENDMENT

In Proposition 5, to insert immediately before the full stop the following:

“, including commentary on how delivery of the Plan has:

- (a) supported or strengthened the Island’s economic capacity and competitiveness;
- (b) involved trade-offs affecting economic growth, resilience or productivity; and
- (c) balanced economic considerations alongside other policy objectives in the delivery of super priorities”.

Rule 4(1) Information

- a) The proposition contributes to the States’ objectives and policy plans by adding criteria to strengthen the reporting of economic considerations with respect to the Government Work Plan.
- b) In preparing the proposition, consultation has been undertaken with the Policy & Resources Committee.
- c) The proposition has been submitted to His Majesty’s Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) There are no direct financial implications to the States of carrying the proposal into effect.
- e) Drafting advice has been sought from the States’ Greffier and advice has been sought from Officers of the Policy & Resources Committee.

Explanatory note

This amendment recognises that the Island's ability to deliver public services, infrastructure investment and social outcomes depends fundamentally on maintaining and strengthening economic capacity.

The amendment does not mandate growth targets, sector strategies or delivery methods. Instead, it strengthens strategic coherence, transparency and accountability by ensuring that economic consequences and trade-offs are visible when priorities are set, sequenced and delivered and that future reporting on them includes sufficient commentary to evidence these considerations and their impacts.
