AMENDMENT

In proposition 9, to insert immediately after "2026" the following:

“, subject to deleting the words “Dave Ferguson Hall” in Clause 1 paragraph 1 of the Ordinance and substituting therefor the words “Sir John Loveridge Hall””.

Rule 4(1) Information

- a) The proposition contributes to the States' objectives and policy plans by facilitating democratic elections to the office of People's Deputy.
- b) This is a Committee amendment.
- c) The proposition has been submitted to His Majesty's Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) There are no financial implications to the States of carrying the proposal into effect.
- e) Drafting advice has been sought from the States' Greffier.

Explanatory note

This amendment is required to reflect the change of room at Beau Sejour for the by-election and count, which will now take place in the Sir John Loveridge Hall. The Dave Ferguson Hall was originally booked for this purpose but is no longer available, making the allocation of an alternative venue essential.
