**Alderney Airport Runway Rehabilitation**

**AMENDMENT**

Proposed by: Deputy N R Inder

Seconded by: Deputy A H Brouard

To insert the following after proposition 2:-

“In the event that the States approve Propositions 1 and 2: -

“3. To agree that the amount of money payable by the States out of general revenue to fund the service to be provided under the current Alderney Public Service Obligation contract shall, as from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024, be limited to £1 million per annum.

4. To agree that the amount of money payable by the States out of general revenue to fund an Alderney service to be provided under any successor replacement contract to the current Alderney Public Service Obligation contract shall, as from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026 and thereafter, be limited to £1 million per annum.

OR in the event that Proposition 4 is not approved

5. To agree that the amount of money payable by the States out of general revenue to fund an Alderney service to be provided under any successor replacement contract to the current Alderney Public Service Obligation contract shall, as from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026 and thereafter, be limited to £500,000 per annum.

OR in the event that Propositions 4 and 5 are not approved

6. To agree that no funding shall be provided out of general revenue to fund an Alderney service when the current Alderney Public Service Obligation contract comes to an end.””

#### **Rule 4(1) Information**

- a) The propositions contribute to the States' objectives in that they seek to reduce States' expenditure
- b) In preparing the propositions, no consultation has been undertaken with other Committees or relevant stakeholders.
- c) The propositions have been submitted to His Majesty's Comptroller for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) The propositions would reduce the cost to the States of the subsidy required to deliver the Alderney air service.
