Rule 4(1) Information

- a. The proposition contributes to the States’ objectives and policy plans by ensuring the States of Deliberation is elected by means of an effective electoral system.
- b. There has been consultation with the Committee. Recognising the interest of other stakeholders, the amendment has been circulated for comment to the Policy & Resources Committee and the Committee *for* Home Affairs.
- c. The proposition has been submitted to His Majesty’s Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d. There are no additional funding costs associated with the amendment as the work can be undertaken within existing budgeted resources.
