**Preparation of a New Electoral Roll**

**AMENDMENT**

After Proposition 2, to insert the following propositions:

“3. To agree that the Committee *for* Home Affairs and the Policy & Resources Committee shall investigate potential opportunities of using the data from the next electoral roll for the purposes of updating the Register of Contact Details and to report back by 30 September 2024.”

**Rule 4(1) Information**

- a) The proposition contributes to the States’ objectives and policy plans by improving the resilience, security and governance of public services.
- b) In preparing the propositions, consultation has been undertaken with the Committee *for* Home Affairs.
- c) The proposition has been submitted to His Majesty’s Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) There are no financial implications to the States of carrying the proposal into effect.

### Explanatory note

As a new Electoral Roll will be created for the 2025 General Election, this presents an opportunity for Electoral Roll data, which will be up to date by virtue of just having been collected, to be used to populate and update the States' Register of Contact details.

It is understood that before any decision can be made as to the use of the data that exploratory work is undertaken first.
