To insert an additional proposition, as follows:

“17. To agree that the President of the Committee *for* Housing should be added to the list in Band B in Table 2 (paragraph 4.4 of the Policy Letter) and the Members of the Committee *for* Housing should be added to the list of those in Band C in that same table.”

Rule 4(1) Information

- a) The propositions do not contribute to the States' objectives and policy plans.
- b) In preparing the propositions, there has been no consultation with stakeholders.
- c) The propositions have been submitted to His Majesty's Procureur for advice on any legal or constitutional implications.
- d) The Proposition has a maximum financial implication of £12,833, that being the difference between the pay of a Principal Committee Member and a President. (Costings in the Policy Letter have been prepared on the basis of the highest possible cost and assume that Members all have seats on Committees.)
- e) Drafting advice was sought from the Officers of the Policy & Resources Committee and the States' Greffier.

Explanatory note

The decision by the States to create a Committee *for* Housing means that an additional Principal Committee President will be required and therefore, for the sake of good order, the Committee is seeking to ensure that the role in question is included in the list of Presidents in Band B, and also that the Members of the Committee *for* Housing are included in Band C.

The maximum remuneration payable under this system is £2,154,694 (assuming that Alderney Representatives do not occupy a position as a President of a Committee or as a Member of the Policy & Resources Committee).
