**RE-APPOINTMENT OF THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR AS RESPONSIBLE OFFICER UNDER THE

- I. After consideration of the Policy Letter entitled 'Re-Appointment of the Medical Director as Responsible Officer under the Regulation of Health Professions (Medical Practitioners) (Guernsey and Alderney) Ordinance, 2015.' dated 9th January, 2026 they were of the opinion:-
  1. To re-appoint Dr Peter Rabey as Responsible Officer for Guernsey and Alderney under section 10(1) of The Regulation of Health Professions (Medical Practitioners) (Guernsey and Alderney) Ordinance, 2015, for both classes of medical practitioners for whom revalidation is required (being UK Connected Practitioners and Local Practitioners) - such appointment to take effect from 8th March 2026 for a period of 5 years, after the expiry of his current term of office.

ALDERNEY AIRPORT RUNWAY REHABILITATION – DELEGATED AUTHORITY

- V. After consideration of the Policy Letter entitled ‘Alderney Airport Runway Rehabilitation – Delegated Authority’ dated 9th January, 2026, they were of the opinion:-

1. To authorise the Policy & Resources Committee to proceed with the procurement process for the rehabilitation of the Alderney Airport runway, based on the design outlined in section 5, by issuing an invitation to tender with the intent to engage in early contractor involvement.
2. To delegate authority to the Policy & Resources Committee to approve funding of up to £24 million from the General Revenue Reserve, subject to approval of an appropriately detailed business case for the rehabilitation of the Alderney runway, based on the design outlined in section 5.
3. To direct the Policy & Resources Committee to work with the States' Trading Supervisory Board and the States of Alderney to ensure best value is achieved.
4. To direct the Policy & Resources Committee to report back to the States of Deliberation upon completion of the tender process, confirming the final contract value.
