"Through the Committee's responses last week to Rule 14 questions, it has become clear that neither the Committee (or its predecessor) were advised for 3.5 months (between November and 13th February) as they should have been, by a "limited number of senior officers" of key information in the management of Phase 2 of the 'Our Hospital Modernisation Programme, of particular political significance in view of the Government Work Plan debate in January.

"In light of this, does the Committee take the view that the comment previously made by the Head of the Public Service that the conduct of a number of officers associated with the OHM programme fell significantly short of required standards, applies equally to the "limited number of senior officers" who advise the Policy and Resources Committee?"
